Application Guidelines on Spiritual Leadership Scholarship

Introduction

Gratia Christian College has established a Spiritual Leadership Scholarship to honour students who demonstrate good Christian faith and leadership.

Thanks to the generous contribution from the **Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada (PAOC)**, the scholarship in the amount of HK\$5,000 will be awarded to one student in each academic year. Students of any year and any programme are welcome to apply for the scholarship.

Implementation

Student Development Office (SDO) is responsible for administering the Scholarship. Details of this Scholarship are given in the following table:

Applicants will be invited to attend an interview conducted by a Selection Panel.3. The Panel will submit a nomination to the Academic Board for consideration and endorsement.4. Awardee will be informed of the result after the endorsement.

30-31 May 2023 (Tue and Wed)	<p><u>Selection Interview</u></p> <p>Shortlisted applicants will attend an individual interview conducted by a Selection Panel who will nominate an awardee for the Scholarship</p>
9 June 2023	<p><u>Endorsement of Nomination</u></p> <p>Nomination to be endorsed by the Academic Board</p>
Mid July 2023	<p><u>Announcement of Result</u></p> <p>SDO will inform all applicants of the result by email</p>
Early September 2023	<p><u>Presentation of Award</u></p> <p>Award will be presented during the 1st College Assembly of AY2023-24</p>
